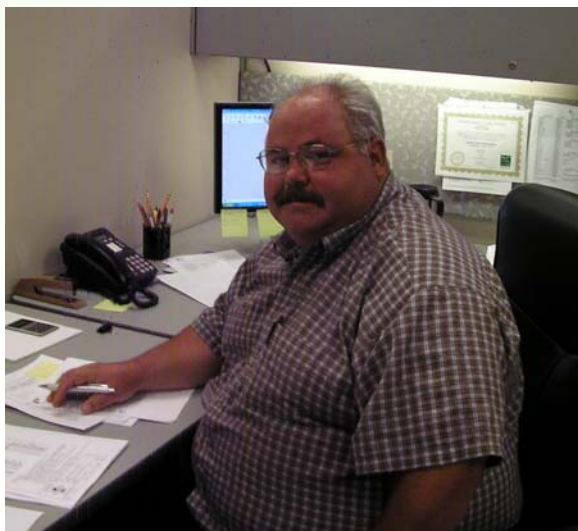
PFS Expands and Strengthens Both HUD-Code Home and Modular Home Plan Review Capability
